Official Contestant Rules & Regulations

The following rules and regulations for cooks at the Anaheim RV Village Resort, are as follows:

1. This is not a Traditional International Chili Society Event, anything goes as any kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with red chili peppers, various spices and other ingredients, with the exception of any pre-made Chile, Corn Bread and or Desserts which are strictly forbidden.
 2. Chili Verde is defined by as any kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with green chili peppers, various spices and other ingredients.
 3. Salsa: there are no rules as to the ingredients or how to prepare your Salsa. It may be prepared at home and brought to the site that day, or it may be store bought and brought to the site, or it may be prepared at the Cook off.
 4. Cooking during entire cooking period is at the sole discretion of the contestant.
 5. A representative of the sponsoring organization shall conduct a contestant's meeting, at which time final instructions are to be given and questions answered, no later than 1 hour prior to the official starting time of the cook off.
 6. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils, etc. The sponsors of the cook off will provide an area for each contestant and in some instances stoves and/or electrical outlets. (We have electrical for you) no stoves.
You can cook in your RV
 7. Each contestant must cook a minimum of one Gallon of competition chili prepared in one pot, which will be submitted for judging, at this event the judges will come to you.
 8. Contestants will not be permitted to sell any Chile, Corn Bread, and or Desserts.
 9. Each contestant will be assigned a contestant's number by the Chief Scorekeeper. At sign in. **All entry must be check in at 4:30pm** Judging will start immediately.
 10. Judges will be told they should **vote for the chili** they like best based on the following major considerations:
Good Flavor, Blend of Spices, and Aroma.
 11. Judges will be told they should **vote for the Korn Bread** they like best based on the following major considerations: **Appearance, Taste, and Creativity.**
 12. Judges will be told they should **vote for the Dessert** they like best based on the following major considerations: **Creativity, Appearance, and Taste.**
 13. The decisions of the Chief Judge shall be final.
